Lane Closures Coming to Big Beaver from Adams to I-75

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with the City of Troy, expects to begin slab replacement work on Big Beaver in Troy that will result in lane closures on large sections of the road between Adams and I-75. This work is being administered by the RCOC. It is expected to last until approximately November 15.

Adams Road will be closed at Big Beaver as the Adams/Big Beaver intersection is reconstructed. It is expected to start approximately August 18. During the Adams closure, the detour route for Adams traffic will be Maple Road to Coolidge Highway to Wattles Road and back to Adams and vice versa. Traffic on Big Beaver through the intersection will be maintained on one lane in each direction for up to four (4) weeks. Significant delays should be expected.

Access to homes, offices and businesses will be maintained throughout the duration of construction, though there may be periods when heavy equipment or barricades may impede access.

Slab replacements on Big Beaver from Adams to I-75 are expected to follow the Adams/Big Beaver intersection work, however; some of this work may overlap with the intersection reconstruction. Work schedules and lane closures will be announced by the RCOC during the course of the project.

The work on Big Beaver Road is part of a \$10.5 million Troy/RCOC comprehensive concrete replacement program to address heavy pothole damage and generally poor conditions on RCOC roads. Roads completed so far this year by Troy's contractor include John R from Long Lake to Maple, Long Lake from Rochester to I-75, and Long Lake from Northfield Parkway to I-75.

Troy is also administering slab replacement work on Big Beaver from Rochester to Dequindre. Eastbound Big Beaver road construction started on Monday, August 4. One lane of traffic is maintained between Rochester and Dequindre for the duration of the work. Construction is anticipated to last for up to four weeks. All eastbound lanes are anticipated to be open by August 31, 2014.

Roadwork on Big Beaver westbound lanes will follow. Construction on the westbound lanes is anticipated to start after Labor Day and last for up to four weeks. All westbound lanes are anticipated to be open by September 30, 2014.
